Dear Parents and Teachers,

We would like to take this opportunity to give you information about the end of school event and Kermesse on Saturday 28th June and also to ask for your help in finding a number of items. Thank you to those of you who have already volunteered to help us on the day. We still need lots of help with running the Kermesse stalls, setting up in the morning, transferring the food for the picnic after the show and clearing up in the evening. Please feel free to help out wherever you can during the day.

Please note there is a change of timetable for the day:

- 8:00 Set up of Kermesse stalls, picnic tables and drinks by parent volunteers
- 9:00 Please bring your children to the Primary School with your food dishes for the picnic
- 9:00-9:30 Coffee and opportunity to buy Yearbooks, tea towels, DVDs and tickets for the Kermesse stalls in the foyer of the Gymnase
- 9:30-11:30 Awards Ceremony and Show in the Gymnase (building in the car park at the Lycee end of the school)
- 12:00-13:30 Potluck Picnic lunch (in the school grounds between the Gymnase and Primary School)
- 13:30-15:30 Kermesse

If you have already signed up to help, please could you bear in mind that all the jobs (setting up, clearing up and stalls) will start 30 minutes earlier than originally planned.

Picnic lunch

Please be aware that we don't have any refrigerators and so any food you drop off at 9:00 at the Primary School will be stored at room temperature in a classroom until the picnic at 12:00. We would like to remind you as well to bring lots of drinks as most of the day will be spent outside. Please could you either pre-cut any cakes or quiches or bring serving utensils such as knives, salad servers or spoons to make serving as easy as possible. We would also appreciate any (named) cool boxes with freezer packs to help us keep drinks as cool as possible.

We will be providing recyclable plates, cups and cutlery so please put them in the marked bags or bins after you have finished eating so we can wash and reuse them.

Kermesse

For those of you who may not be familiar with a Kermesse, there will be approximately 20 stalls or games for you to accompany your children to. To be able to play the games, you will need to purchase tickets, as each stall will cost 1 ticket. The tickets will be on sale at the morning coffee, immediately after the show and throughout the afternoon. Look for the Caisse sign. The tickets will cost 1 Euro for 3 tickets or 5 Euros for 20 tickets so please remember to bring some change with you to buy them for your children. All profits will be used for the benefit of the school community.

We still need a volunteer to video the awards ceremony and show for us; please let us know if you can help.

Please remember to bring lots of drinks, sunscreen, sun hats and cameras!

We look forward to seeing you on Saturday for what promises to be a very enjoyable family day and wish you all a very relaxing summer holiday.
